ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, the incentive for Coastal Shipping has been fixed at the rate of 10% above the road transportation cost as per the NATPAC study report (as base rate) for a period of six months and as per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, the same was extended for another one year from 23.01.2021.

2. As per the Government Order read as 3rd paper above, sanction was accorded to disburse the operation incentive per loaded containers as per the table given below for the extended period and also ordered that a minimum of 20% of the incentive should be shared with the traders/exporters/importers, so as to promote the overall coastal shipping activities in the State.

3. As per the letter read above, the Chief Executive Officer, Kerala Maritime Board requested to extend the term of coastal shipping incentive for a further period of two years w.e.f 23/01/2022, so as to attract the shipping trade and vessel operators as a part of coastal shipping in the State.

Having examined the matter in detail, Government are pleased to extend the incentive scheme, sanctioned vide Government order read as 3rd paper above, for a further term of one more year w.e.f 23/01/2022, so as to attract the shipping trade and vessel operators in connection with the coastal shipping movement in the State.
