KMB- Establishment of Sand Purification Plant at Azhikkal- Addendum to the Request for Proposal (RFP ref. No.: KMB-CMD-11-23 dated November 15, 2023)

## Addendum

A Request for Proposal (Ref: RFP No. Ref. No.: KMB-CMD-11-23 dated November 15, 2023 was published on CMD's website pertaining to the establishment of a Sand Purification Plant at Azhikkal. Certain additions/modifications have been made in the initial RFP. The same is given below.

- 1. KMB will make arrangements for testing of the sand to ascertain the percentage of impurities and other components or waste and an upper tolerance limit would be fixed in the agreement to be executed with the plant owner.
- 2. Whatever by-products are generated by the plant owner; he can dispose it of according to his discretion, complying all legal formalities, at his cost.
- 3. The detail statement regarding the price bid evaluation would be submitted in the second cover and a format is enclosed (format 5\*.)
- 4. The basic price is Rs. 1410 (Rupees One Thousand Four Hundred and Ten) plus royalty payable to Geology Department at Rs.80 (Rupees Eighty). So the total price is Rs. 1490 (Rupees One Thousand Four Hundred and Ninety only). The right to establish the plant will go to the bidder who offers the highest amount quoted above the minimum fixed royalty.
  - Rs. 1410 + GST of Rs. 1490 is the amount payable to the Government.
- 5. The entire dredged sand would be given to the plant owner for purification. However, the government may by order reserve a maximum quantity of 25 percent of the quantity dredged annually for departmental purposes.
- 6. For transporting the purified sand sold by the plant owner from his plant to the buyer's premises/place/location, a vehicle pass would be issued by KMB and an amount of Rs.220 (Rupees Two Hundred and Twenty Only) per vehicle plus GST would be collected from the buyer over and above the selling price of the sand fixed. This amount shall be collected by the plant owner and remitted to the KMB on the same date.
- 7. Necessary CRZ clearance for dredging shall be obtained by KMB.
- 8. All required approvals for setting up the plant shall be obtained by the project proponent.

\*A format is given with this Addendum. Bidders should submit the format 5 along with the financial bid.

Interested Bidders requested to go through the modification given above and submit the proposals.

## Financial Bid Statement

The project proponent shall submit the Financial Bid including the additional rate (to be quoted) over the basic price in the following format

- I. The selection will be based on the highest rate quoted as a percentage on the basic price of 1410/- (b)
- II. The quoted price includes share of Kerala Maritime Board, share of LSGD and wages of manual dredging laborers
- III. The GST collected by Kerala Maritime Board from the project proponent can be taken for claiming Input Tax Credit by the project proponent/bidder.
- IV. Royalty payable to Mining and Geology Department shall be collected by the project proponent over and above the selling price and remitted to the Department. (The present rate is Rs.80+GST)
- V. The project proponent shall also collect an amount of Rs 220/- + GST per vehicle as vehicle pass and the same shall be remitted to Kerala Maritime Board
- VI. The selling price/tone fixed is Rs.2000/-+GST
